SHUTDOWN



Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister . . . , pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters,

. . .

Ezekiel 16:49 (KJV)

It was a mere 72 years since Israel's re-founding as a nation, when the COVID pandemic shut down our planet. Yet (physical) disease was not the only inconvenience brewing in our society's upper echelons. For the viable foundation of an enduring society must rest upon both truth and honor: The truth about our past, truth about the present, along with a realistic expectation of future stability. Thus, while coming up to speed, we would best start this discussion upon this most basic premise, as we consider a warning from the world's #1 best selling Book.

If a ruler hearken to lies, all his servants are wicked.

Proverbs 29:12 (KJV)

For a God-fearing person (who takes Bible warnings seriously) this very simple point of reference may bring a serious lump to our throats—Adam's apple, or not. For, consider the cultural tendency of a *non* God fearing society; *not* committed to truth—to continually adopt this and that “little vice” to *get the job done*—especially, as one progresses up the socio-economic ladder into the addictive atmosphere of what we may consider high society. “Now: Wait a minute,” we may object, looking furtively over our shoulder, “Did that text say that *all* his servants are wicked? What about me” . . . and what about anyone dependent upon such decisions?

Must we be so serious about such things? —However, when crossing the playing field we are about to communicate, a safe passage is not easily accomplished if we are careless about things red lining the landmines right at our feet. Fortunately for us, however, there is actually godly wisdom to guard us from the swill that would poison our souls and blow holes into our minds. Let us therefore imagine a society that would actually be governed by our next quotation :

¹³ *Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom.*

James 3:13

Here is a wisdom based upon the simple (ancient?) graces of godly society, which is “first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. (vs 17)

A very simple contrast to these principles is given within the very first chapter of the book of Proverbs. The Proverbs (wise sayings, by King Solomon) open with a general illustration of why we might earnestly crave godly wisdom. For the writer does this by illustrating how the young & careless (or old and foolish...) may endanger both their future & destiny.

It's called “sinning.”

The other side of honor—is virtue

¹⁰ *My son, if sinners entice you, Do not consent. ¹¹ If they say, "Come with us, Let us lie in wait to shed blood; Let us lurk secretly for the innocent without cause; ¹² Let us swallow them alive like Sheol, And whole, like those who go down to the Pit; . . . ¹⁷ Surely, in vain the net is spread In the sight of any bird; . . . they lie in wait for their own blood, They lurk secretly for their own lives.*

Proverbs 1:10-12, 17-18

Notice how he says that “in vain the net is spread in the sight of any bird . . .” In other words, staggering in a mine field is deadly. But from Heaven's perspective; there are red lights visible in that field, flashing a warning to us: “Don't throw your life away!”

In our opening we stated that a stable society/culture must be built upon both truth *and* honor. These “flashing lights” are multifaceted: For

the other side of honor—is virtue. A prostitute cashes in her virtue: While a traitor, puts his honor up for sale. Let us remember this, as we proceed. . .

Jesus Christ came into the world to save sinners. This is the really good news of the gospel. **Jesus went to the Cross to shed His blood and redeem us:**—To “buy back” our honor & virtue, if you will. The apostle Paul wrote about this: telling us why everyone needs a Savior. What is it that propels humanity to say “No” to the God who loves us? Paul uncovers these things.

Paul wrote a letter to the Christians in Rome. Now Rome, in the first century, was *really* a boiling cauldron of the “State” (Deep, or not). He immediately clears the air for us by first stating the obvious (to early Christians) and clearly proclaims his love for the gospel of redemption, for “. . . in it the righteousness of God is revealed from faith to faith; as it is written, ‘*The just shall live by faith.*’” (Romans 1:17).

Being a true teacher of the good news (the gospel) the apostle Paul quickly cuts out the fat, by clearing the air and warning readers to stay clear of what we might call, today, the stench of the “swamp:” atheism, unbelief, and promiscuity.

²⁰ *For since the creation of the world [God's] invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse, ²¹ because, although they knew God, they did not glorify Him as God, nor were thankful, but became futile in their thoughts, and their foolish hearts were darkened.*

²² *Professing to be wise, they became fools,*

Romans 1:20-22

In other words, Paul states in less poetic language than king Solomon, that God has set eternity within the heart of man (Ecclesiastes 3:11). Or, as Blaise Pascal put it, there is a “God shaped vacuum” within each of us, that only God, Himself, can fill. However,

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FIFTH GENERATION WARFARE

*For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood,
but against principalities, against powers, against the
rulers of the darkness of this age, . . .*

Ephesians 6:12

Within the terminal generation, Jesus informs us, much of the Christian church succumbs to falling fast asleep. —Even some of the most astute among us (Matt. 25:1-9).

We need not fly into a panic over this truth (although sleeping is *not* the posture you want to be found in, when “fifth generation warfare” is unleashed, as we will see). Yet we may wish to delineate the terminal generation’s starting point (Israel’s returning to her land—Matt. 24:32-34 & Mk. 13:28-30)—and note what a scriptural “generation” is (approximately 70-80 years—Psalm 90:10).

We might then write a whole compendium of wickedness illustrating all that is “fanning them to sleep” —(notice I said “them” —certainly, such dark media, does its best to affect *us* . . .)

Yet Jesus did say that *some of the best of us* would be sleeping, in one my favorite end time parables. For “Then shall the kingdom of God be like ten virgins,” Jesus says; Noting that while the Bridegroom is delaying (as many are now requesting, in prayerful petition) —they all fall asleep. Surprise, even virgins can fall asleep!

For we (God’s people) are the Bride of Christ—and Jesus calls us “virgins”! Even the apostle Paul states that he had done his best to present the true believer to Christ as a “chaste virgin” (2 Cor. 11:2)—“Chaste” as in pure—not frightened, or running away. . . This is important.

Thus, when John’s Revelation of Jesus Christ (commonly called *The Apocalypse*) —gives us a peek at true believers seen in Heaven itself, we should not be surprised to see them being called virgins. Please note carefully, and with precision, what John saw within his vision:

¹ . . . , and behold, a Lamb standing on Mount

Zion, and with Him one hundred and forty-four thousand, having His Father's name written on their foreheads.

. . . .

⁴ *These are the ones who were not defiled with women, for they are virgins. These are the ones who follow the Lamb wherever He goes. These were redeemed from among men, being firstfruits to God and to the Lamb.*

Revelation 14:1,4 [emphasis added]

Within the seventh chapter of this same Revelation, these 144,000 are described as Jewish believers (Rev. 7:4-8). However, Scripture does not say that they are Evangelists (check the context, in your own Bible)—nor does it say that they are the only ones saved, for an *additional* sea of souls, that we cannot number (you will lose your count in that happy throng)—are also listed within this celebration in Heaven (7:7)! Thus the 144K only denote, it seems, that Christ’s initial mission (as the Messiah of *the Jews*) has been successfully completed in a tangible manner (you can even count them!).

These are the *first fruits* of Heaven’s eternal harvesting of souls, into Heaven’s eternal family—along with the apostle Paul himself (Eph. 1:12). This happy throng has been redeemed by the Lord Jesus Christ who came down into our world, to save us. . . by shedding His precious blood on the Cross (1 Peter 1:19)!

Now, you would think that those within Christ’s parable, or parabolic illustration (parabola: in mathematical terms, describing a line that goes from point “A” to point “B” in a *round about manner*)—you might think that this parabolic experience includes a protected lifestyle among these precious virgins, would you not (but, they fall asleep . . . from presumption...)?

Think about it: Jesus loved to tell stories in parables that were *intentionally* designed to convey secrets, sometimes in “round about” ways. We know this, because He

was asked this very question by disciples in Matthew's gospel (there are four gospels within the New Testament (NT): Gospel means "good news"—yet each section of the NT that has a biography of Jesus' ministry, is also called a "Gospel"—as in the "Gospel of Matthew," or "Gospel of Mark," etc.).

In Matthew's Gospel the disciples asked Jesus, "Why do you tell parables" (round about stories)?? Jesus answered them in a straightforward manner (something that did not always please audiences looking for "entertaining" stories—see John's sixth chapter for examples of this!).

So, "why tell parables, Jesus?"

¹¹ *He answered and said to them, "Because it has been given to you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it has not been given.*

¹² *For whoever has, to him more will be given, and he will have abundance; but whoever does not have, even what he has will be taken away from him.*

Matthew 13:11-12

You may have heard the term "the rich get richer, and the poor get poorer"—that's a way of understanding what Jesus was saying: the more you treasure something, the better you understand it. Further, when you have "inside info" you can also communicate "in code" so to speak. This is how the kingdom of Heaven operates: for those who press in to know God, He reveals His gems to them. This begins by first entering into fellowship (or covenant) with Him. Then, once in the family, you get more and more of the family gems, so to speak. The sweet psalmist David put it this way:

The secret of the LORD is with those who fear Him, And He will show them His covenant.

Psalms 25:14

Covenant is a special "contract of the soul" so to speak: Marriage is a covenant. There are things that married people talk about that is private ("pillow talk"). You get to know the Lord, and He begins to open up His secrets to you. That's the best way to gain an understanding of Bible truths, especially when starting to understand Bible prophecy.

But as it is written: "Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, Nor have entered into the heart of man The things which God has prepared for those who love Him."

But God has revealed them to us by His Spirit . . .

1 Corinthians 2:9,10

. . . And yet, after God has opened up Scripture to us, we also find that the infinite God is also very logical, and well ordered. "Come now," He says, inviting us into His study, "and let us reason together" (Isaiah 1:18)—so, just as a "parabola" (a mathematical representation of a parable) may be described and listed as a mathematical for-

mula—so too, when the Lord opens up Bible Scripture to us, we find it to be quite logical. He can define each symbol within the parable, for example, in a manner similar to assigning values to mathematical symbols—to give to us a logical and correct answer (see Matt. 13:13-23 for an example of this).

In fact (I know this may seem a stretch for some reading this UPLOOK) I do believe that one reason that the Lord does utilize symbols within Bible prophecy is to that *every generation* (not just the one terminal) can seek the Lord's face and find application to the prophetic symbols—to give them encouragement along the way to the *ultimate fulfillment* of those prophecies contained within the Scriptures—for since we are saved by hope, and we need something to look forward to, in the future (Rom. 8:24). This is the ultimate purpose of Bible prophecy (1 Cor. 13:8-9) to give us hope (Rev. 1:3).

Yet . . . this is not what we are referring to, when referring to "fifth generation warfare," which is largely intended to deceive and delude (& fan to sleep...), rather than to inform and to encourage people and nations who are affected by its launch into our world, and the media platforms. No, fifth generation warfare, when unleashed upon the western mind *is* primarily a means of *deceiving* the public into believing and making decisions that will, in the long run, most likely lead them straight into the fires of Hell itself.

Nonetheless, being a Christian, I will resist politically correct fear mongering, to gladly focus upon Heaven's "attack strategy," and reality. Therefore, we will now turn to a documented scene of heavenly warfare—which took place at a time when even the very "first generation" of warfare (where sophisticated field technology, such as the Romans Legions would introduce) was not yet utilized—for simple bows and arrows, swords and clubs, with less sophisticated marching patterns, were still very popular upon earth. Yet believe it or not . . . we might actually think of the enemy insurgents described below as "fourth generational,"—since they are later described as simple "raiders" in verse 23 of that chapter—were it not for the fact that they were, actually, commissioned by a sitting king. The raiders certainly had no guns, which tend to define 2nd generational weapons (machine guns) or heavily armored tanks (a 3rd generational approach)—and they certainly had no aircraft. Finally, they had no cell phones, computers, or satellites (or Facebook, or Instagram) which are favorites for crowd control and cultural manipulation within the "fifth generation" model of modern "warfare."

The guys standing on this field of battle were simply "blood and guts" warriors.

Yet Heaven already had superior forces dispatched that were, to some critics of fifth generational warfare, to be described as using "magic."* Interesting, however, how some things never seem to change—for the enemy within the following scenario was found to be located in ancient

Syria, and the ones that Heaven was protecting . . . were in Israel. We will quote a small section of Scripture to give the flavor of Israel's "intelligence gathering" on this occasion.

⁸ Now the king of Syria was making war against Israel; and he consulted with his servants, saying, "My camp will be in such and such a place."⁹ And the man of God sent to the king of Israel, saying, "Beware that you do not pass this place, for the Syrians are coming down there."

¹⁰ Then the king of Israel sent someone to the place of which the man of God had told him. Thus he warned him, and he was watchful there, not just once or twice.

2 Kings 6:8-10

Not being aware that Israel's chief prayer warrior was able to outwit the best that Syria had to offer, the king of Syria started to search the ranks of his government for a whistle blower. "Who's leaking our secrets to Israel?" he wanted to know. Someone in Syria's ranks was a truly wise man, and he informed the king that Israel had a prophet who could even reveal the king of Syria's "pillow talk" to the Israeli leadership (vs. 12).

"Where is this prophet?" the king wanted to know, and he discovered through Syrian intelligence that Elisha was residing in a town called Dothan. So, you know what the king of Syria did: he had hundreds of the best armed men on the planet, dispatched to apprehend the prophet. Their object was to perform a "no knock" visit of Elisha, early in the morning. Our story picks up from the time Elisha and his servant awoken in the morning:

¹⁵ And when the servant of the man of God arose early and went out, there was an army, surrounding the city with horses and chariots. And his servant said to him, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?"¹⁶ So he answered, "Do not fear, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them."¹⁷ And Elisha prayed, and said, "LORD, I pray, open his eyes that he may see." Then the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw. And behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

2 Kings 6:15-17

Imagine that: an army of angels with fiery chariots, dispatched to protect Elisha. In another encounter, a single angel wiped out 185,000 men in response to the prayers of king Hezekiah (2 Kings 19:35). This time, Elisha utilizes what we might describe as "grace warfare" by simply instructing the angelic host to blind the Syrian army, as he led them to where Israel's army would have them surrounded—then, instead of killing their army or taking them captive—they prepared a feast for them, (following their "Geneva Convention") and

sent them home. "So the bands of Syrian raiders came no more into the land of Israel" (2 K. 6:23—this is not to say that Syria gave up on harassing Samaria, read the rest of the chapter!!).

Interesting, that the Apocalypse makes note of the fact that at the end of the age, during the "restoration of all things" (including special, spiritual warfare—Acts 3:21??)—there will appear to be "two witnesses" who are supernaturally empowered to proclaim the judgments of God, in a manner that will be utterly invincible: they even exercise power over the weather (Rev. 11:6)—until the time of their ministry's completion. And it is here that the prophecy (at first) seems to become illogical, noting:

⁷ When they finish their testimony, the beast that ascends out of the bottomless pit will make war against them, overcome them, and kill them.

Revelation 11:7 [emphasis added]

Why will the "beast" (code name for the Antichrist) have to "make war" against these people? They are certainly not immortal (as the verse makes abundantly clear)—and within today's modern warfare environment a simple predator drone might be easily "take them out." Why this notation concerning warfare? For several reasons:

This brings into alignment a fuller description of the "beast's" war with the saints, as mentioned within the thirteenth chapter vs. 7 (note that chapters eleven, and 12 - 13 are two parallel prophecies. See the book *When It is Time* :chapters 11-14, for a fuller explanation of this phenomena).

Warfare, against "two witnesses," within a chapter that takes pains to alert us to the *spiritual nature* of this chapter (see vs. 8) —points to the possibility of this being a *remnant of believers*, consisting of many more than two literal persons.

At the time of this passage's fulfillment, this world (our world) will feel far more comfortable with dealing with a group of "religious fanatics" via Instagram and Facebook, than with guns and bullets by utilizing, what is today called, "fifth generation warfare" —the war of words and ideas within the public square.

This last conclusion also explains why, when the "two witnesses" are killed—the entire world celebrates by sending gifts to one another (Rev. 11:10)!

In any event, whatever the means of warfare that humankind may mount against the God of Heaven —Let us remember what the Psalmist observed of the outcome.

¹ Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing? . . . ⁴ . . . He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The LORD shall hold them in derision. . . .

⁶ "Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion."

Psalm 2:1-6

God still has everything under control—even in a day of fifth generational warfare! †

(Continued from page 3) . . . **SHUTDOWN** when ignoring that “vacuum” we will all ultimately . . . implode, like an old fashioned glass light bulb, as we collapse under the weight of guilt that will ultimately confront us, when we stand before God—either now, while forgiveness is offered—or later, when it is just too late.

Paul continues:

²⁶ *For this reason God gave them up to vile passions. For even their women exchanged the natural use for what is against nature.* ²⁷ *Likewise also the men, . . .* ²⁸ *And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a debased mind, to do those things which are not fitting;*

Romans 1:26-28

It is at this point that it seems most fitting to take a leap from plain text on preaching the truth (& the consequences) into a transition made clear by the apostle John, who also penned for us the *Revelation*. John now opens our eyes to the concept of the ultimate “Evil One” at the end of the age—who will make Adolf Hitler look like a girl scout (yes, a real “girl”).

I speak of The Antichrist (stick with me, here, please: we are going somewhere . . .).

¹⁸ *Little children, it is the last hour; and as you have heard that the Antichrist is coming, even now many antichrists have come, by which we know that it is the last hour.*

1 John 2:18

Two points are worth noting, before moving quickly on:

1. This very concept of The Antichrist, points to the prior coming of *the Christ*.
2. This very fact; that Christ has come, lets us know that we are now in the post-Christ era, and that it is *now* the “last hour” (i.e. we are already, by definition, in “the endtimes.”)

Therefore, *all of Christ’s warnings* within His discourse concerning the

end times (especially, warnings to beware of a spiritual deception that seeks to cause us to “cash in” our faith & virtue (in Matt. 24, Mark 13, Luke 17 & 21) are to be taken *seriously TODAY*.

The Bible also contains a specific prophecy that flags the rise of homosexuality within the culture of the end times. I have taken a good deal of time preparing our minds for this prescription for a “final shutdown.” The most important concept to keep in mind, however, is the stunning accuracy of God’s timing for this event. The UPLOOK has often emphasized the viability of seeking God’s face for mercy NOW, in this hour, in order to experience an extension of His grace and mercy (and freedoms) experienced within our country and world. The purpose of our exposition here, however, is to realize the incredible accuracy of devastating judgments that *have already begun* in relation to the following prophecy.

We now quote again, our opening text, along with its social context:

⁴⁹ *Look, this was the iniquity of your sister Sodom: She and her daughter had pride, fullness of food, and abundance of idleness; . . .* ⁵⁰ *And they were haughty and committed abomination before Me; therefore I took them away as I saw fit.*

Ezekiel 16:49-50

This is what we may consider to be the first part of the prophecy: in it we see its main, underlying components:

Pride
Abundance
Abundance of idleness

Each of the above components are quite fluent within western society today, (even our “wealth” which most in the West take for granted). The Pride (with a capital “P”) already is “in your face” and will no doubt again run rampant, within Gay Pride month (in June). **The “abundance of idleness” was actually enforced by the pandemic lockdown: bending (& break-**

ing?) the will of the mightiest economies upon earth.

Now to see the projected timing of this “social reset” as cited **within a historical context**:

⁵³ *“When I bring back their captives, the captives of Sodom and her daughters, and the captives of Samaria and her daughters, then I will also bring back the captives of your captivity among them, . . .*

Ezekiel 16:53, 55

The above prophecy was addressed by the prophet Ezekiel—to **the nation of Israel**, long before the Diaspora foretold by Christ in Luke’s Gospel (Luke 21:20-24).

- What Sodom represents in the above passages is obvious (LGBTQ+).
- Samaria represents a mixture of true and false religion—which can only happen *after* true (Christian) religion has been established within the culture at large (and which is now easily be observed within “woke” culture, today).

All three of the above prophesied events have been dutifully fulfilled within the past seventy years since Israel’s return to her land.

We can only surmise, if we are honest with ourselves before God, that future impending judgments also cited within Scripture, are just as certain.

How will these judgments become more obvious?

The most evident means by which our culture and world is now marching towards judgment is increasingly evidenced through “fifth generation warfare”—which will bring us to the final shutdown, wherein the Mark of the beast will be issued (Rev. 13:16-18).

—Against such warfare only serious Christian prayer and virtuous living, may protect us.

What Must I do?

“Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you will be saved.”

Acts 16:31

How?

If you will confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus, and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

For with the heart man believes unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Romans 10:9,10

In Other Words

Acknowledge: your need

—as a sinner (Romans 3:23, II Cor. 5:14-15)

Accept: His work on the Cross —to be your Savior

Confess: your acceptance of His lordship over you.

Live for Him: with your new life!

For the scripture says, “Whoever believes on Him will not be ashamed.”

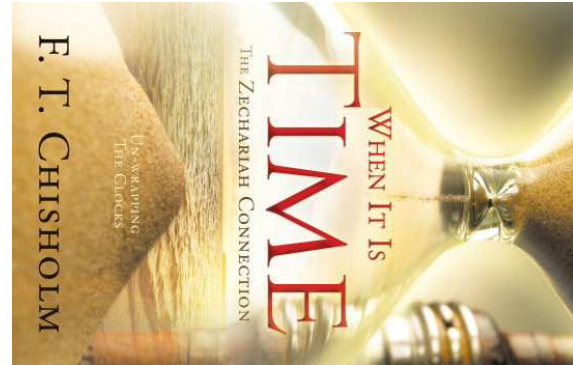
